As you know, St. John Brébeuf serves the English speaking community of LaSalle and also many outside of LaSalle. Our community is vibrant and is blessed with many volunteers who serve you in their different capacities:

HOPE Society (serving the needy of the community... more than 60 families a month and over 200 baskets at Christmas time for needy families and people who live alone).

Faith First (we help to introduce Jesus Christ to over 200 children also preparing them for their First Communion and Confirmation).

Teen Group (teens who meet and have different activities).

Baptism team (we celebrate Baptisms every month and this team helps not only for the preparation of the celebration but also to introduce new and older parents to the Church and the teachings of Jesus Christ).

Liturgy team (who help us celebrate with joy and love).

Ministers of hospitality (a group of

parishioners who welcome you at our celebrations and who organize different activities during the year as fund raisers for the Parish), and many, many more committees who are involved in the daily functioning of the Parish.

Our Parish must also take care of the buildings that are entrusted to it and the general upkeep of these buildings such as electricity, heating and general repairs. All of this is not possible without your generous help and dues are one way to contribute to the existing but also to the future of our community.
